Scouts Australia NSW are running the 6th ADVANCED SCOUT LEADERSHIP COURSE in Newcastle on March 16 and 17, 2012.

This will be a residential course for Scouts who have already shown they are great leaders within their own Scout Troop and want to take it to a new level. The course is challenging and explores your understanding of your own leadership abilities. This course is conducted under a 'learn by doing' methodology and is aimed at developing your Leadership Skills for life.

The Details

We will be starting Saturday morning at 8am sharp. If you are travelling a long distance you may arrive Friday night – leaders will be on site from 8pm. It is best if Scouts arrive Saturday morning.

We will all leave Sunday around 3pm. Closing is at 2pm, parental involvement would be appreciated. Travel to and from the course will be at your own expense.

Accommodation and Cost

Accommodation will be at a Scout Facility. You will need a tent and all sleeping gear. You will need to be prepared to share your tent with other scouts of the same gender. Cost is \$65 for the weekend. This includes meals from Saturday lunch until Sunday lunch.
