

TRY SCOUTS BADGE

If you are 10 years old and are enjoying your time in Cubs, then you can get the **Try Scouts** badge. This badge is given to you by a Patrol Leader from the Scout Troop when you have completed 2 activities with the Troop.



The badge does not replace the Scout Link Badge. The award of the badge is approved by the Troop Council and awarded by the Patrol Leader who has helped get it.

The badge will be presented at the end of the second activity. The badge can be worn on the right shoulder of your Cub Scout uniform. This badge is only available in New South Wales.

Requirements

1. Take part in a Scout Troop activity for one day out of doors
Or
Stay overnight with the Troop on an activity
2. Take part in a joint activity with the Scout Troop and the Cub Pack
