



Suggested Personal Equipment List for AJ2019

Revision 1 - September 2017

This is the packing list as recommended by the NSW Contingent for both youth members and adults. All items must be transported to and from AJ2019 in the supplied NSW Contingent 90L travel bag or 20L backpack/daypack. Any gear that cannot fit into the supplied Jamboree bags cannot go on the bus. Externally packed gear is not allowed.

Personal Luggage Limitations: For safety reasons, flammable liquids and other dangerous goods must not be carried in your luggage.

Prohibited items include: Matches, lighters, any aerosol, methylated spirits, paints, gun powder and some cleaning agents. Under no circumstances are youth members allowed a knife or multi-tool of any description at the Jamboree.

Please do not send any aerosols. The propellant damages the fabric of tents and some kids get asthma if they are sprayed in confined areas.

Non-recommended items include: Portable CD players, electronic games, and other electronic entertainment equipment like iPods or other MP3 players. They are easy to lose, cannot be recharged, and don't work well if dropped in the mud.

Mobile phones: There will be no facilities for youth members to charge mobile phones at the Jamboree, and there is a risk that phones may be lost, damaged or even stolen. There are payphones at the Jamboree site. We advise parents not to send mobile phones with their Scouts to the Jamboree.

Small FM radio. If you have a small inexpensive FM radio, you can bring it and some spare batteries. There will be a Jamboree radio station on site with music, news and interviews.

The Scout 'green book' should be taken to Jamboree, but should not be taken out of the Troop camp site.

Stretchers: We strongly encourage Scouts to sleep on stretchers rather than sleeping mats or air beds. They will be off the ground and bedding will stay a lot cleaner. The stretcher must fit in the Jamboree bag so don't get a huge stretcher and make sure that the stretcher you get folds down well. Bus drivers are not allowed to take loose stretchers or any stretchers attached to the outside of the bag.

Label Everything (we mean EVERYTHING!)

There will be over 10,000 Scouts at AJ2019 and they will all have the same AJ2019 Jamboree hat, scarf and shirt. NSW Scouts will also all have the same NSW Contingent polo shirt. Things will get lost, mislaid or picked up by the wrong person (because they all look the same). If things are labelled, there is a reasonable chance that they will be returned to your Jamboree campsite. If they are not labelled, you have no chance. Label **everything** with your **name** and **troop number**. Scouts will be washing their clothes at Jamboree, so label underwear, towels, raincoats... absolutely everything!

General Clothing Items

- 1 x Uniform Polo Shirt / Belt / Group Scarf / Woggle / Pants / Shorts / Socks
- 2 x Pullover, Windcheater or Jumper (warm)
- 4 x Pairs of Shorts
- 5 x T-Shirts (collar style recommended, 2 will get wet or dirty)
- 5 x Changes of Underwear (minimum!)
- 5 x Pairs of socks (minimum!)
- 6 x Handkerchiefs or 1 Box of Tissues (plastic / sealed)
- 2 x Pairs of Long Trousers, Jeans or Track Suit Pants
- 2 x Sneakers, Track Shoes or Joggers, or boots (enclosed footwear is to be worn at all times)
- 1 x Extra pair of shoes for water activities or mud use (these will get wet and muddy)
- 1 x Spare Pillow Case
- 1 x Wide Brimmed, Soft, Floppy Hat

- 1 x Swimming Costume (Bathers and Rashie)
- 1 x Hat (Broad rimmed are much preferred)
- 1 x Bathing Cap (optional)

Bedding

- 2 x Pairs of Pyjamas/Sleepwear/Track suit (to be used only for sleeping)
- 1 x Small Pillow
- 1 x Sleeping Bag
- 1 x Inner sheet for sleeping bag (optional)
- 1 x Teddy bear (optional)
- 1 x Camp Stretcher or sleeping mat (must fit inside your NSW Contingent 90L bag)

Eating Utensils

- 1 x Dilly Bag - clearly labelled
- 1 x Knife, Fork, Spoon, and Teaspoon
- 1x Bowl (unbreakable - melamine, plastic, aluminium, etc)
- 1x Plate (unbreakable)
- 1x Mug (unbreakable)
- 2 x old tea towels (don't expect to get them back - would really want them back after being used at an outdoor camp for nearly two weeks?)

Wet Weather Gear

- 1 x Lightweight waterproof jacket, Raincoat, Japara Jacket or Poncho

Toiletries

- 1 x Face Washer
- 2 x Towels (one for showers, one for water activities)
