All applicants are reminded that attendance at a Jamboree is a privilege, not a right, and that behaviour standards will be monitored prior to the event before final approval is granted for attendance.

Camping with family, schools etc. will not be considered.• Have approval from their Scout Leader• Have approval from the Contingent Leader• Have consent from their parents/guardian• Not have had their 15th birthday before the opening day of the Jamboree |
| Venturer Scout | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be registered as a Venturer Scout member of Scouts Australia NSW at the time of application and through till 16 January 2019• Be 15 years of age with at least 6 months service as a Venturer, before the opening day of the Jamboree, and should not have reached their 18 years by the end of the Jamboree• Have completed either the<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Australia Scout Medallion; OR○ Award or Venturing Skills Award; OR○ Introduction to Venturer Scouts badge, as well as Stage 3 in each of Bushcraft, Bushwalking and Camping• Have a desire to provide service to Scouts• Be recommended by the Unit Council and Venturer Leader as being of excellent character, a good role model to Scouts and has the skills and abilities to undertake the activity (or other tasks) nominated on the application form• Have approval from the Contingent Leader• Have consent from their parents/guardian |
| Rover Scout | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be registered as a Rover member of Scouts Australia NSW at the time of application and through till 16 January 2019• Be 18 years of age before the opening day of the Jamboree• Be recommended by their Crew Leader as being of excellent character, a good role model to Scouts and has the skills and abilities to undertake the activity (or other tasks) nominated on the application form• Be approved by the Contingent Leader• Not have had their 26th Birthday before the opening day of the Jamboree |
| Leader | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must hold a Certificate of Adult Appointment in Scouts Australia NSW as at 30 September 2018 and through till 16 January 2019• Be recommended by their Group Leader (or Leader-In-Charge)• Be recommended by their Sectional Commissioner• Be approved by the Contingent Leader |

Scouts, once your application is formally accepted and moved to BHQ Approved status, your Leaders will work together with input from youth members to set up a Jamboree Troop with Jamboree Patrols. Your Scout Leader, Group Leader and Region Jamboree Formation Support Leader will be able to support you during this process. Around May / June 2018, a Contingent Welfare Leader will be appointed to look after your Troop and will support you from there.

A Jamboree is, for most Scouts, a once in the life time opportunity, with life time lasting memories and new friendships. A Jamboree allows our youth members to share in new adventures and develop new skills, independence and maturity.

The NSW AJ2019 Contingent team is set up to support your Jamboree journey and experience.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications for the Jamboree must be completed and 'submitted' online. When you have 'submitted' your application, you then need to print it and:

- Under 18 years old (Scouts and Venturers): ensure that both parents and/or guardians (where applicable) sign the Agreement, Activities and Authority form and tick the appropriate 4 boxes for Activities, Authority and Court Order.
- Leaders, Rovers and Other Adult Members: ensure that the Agreement, Activities and Authority form is signed by yourself.

Then all applicants need to obtain the required signatures as follows:

Scouts	Your Scout Leader and Group Leader are required to sign your application form
Venturer Scouts	Your Venturer Leader and Group Leader are required to sign your application form
Leaders / Rovers / Other Adults	Crew / Group Leader or next appropriate level of Commissioner to sign your form

After ensuring you have made your First payment, and have the required signatures, you will be required to login to the Jamboree Application System and upload the agreement page.

All Applications must be completed, reviewed, signed and uploaded by **16 March 2018**, including having made at least the first payment.

Late applications received by NSW Contingent after 16 March 2018:

- May be accepted if there is room in the planned Jamboree Troop and/or arranged Contingent travel plans.
- Applicants may not be with their home Troop if Jamboree Troops have already been formed and no space is available.
- Applicants cannot be guaranteed any or all of the standard Contingent supplied merchandise, nor will there be a reduction in the amount payable if some items are not available.
- Late applications received by the Contingent after **1 June 2018** will attract a \$250 'Late Fee' payable with the initial payment.
 - A late application is defined as any application where the initial payment has not been received by the NSW Contingent on or before the **31st May 2018**.
- All applications will close on 31 August 2018.

Acknowledgement of receipt of your Application and First Payment will be by way of a **Welcome to the NSW Contingent Newsletter**, which will be received via email to your main, validated email address entered on your Online Application.

WITHDRAWALS

If after making application, you are unable to attend the Jamboree, you must advise your Region Jamboree Formation Support Leader (RJFSL) in writing as soon as possible. A withdrawal form will then be made available to you. Please complete this form, Scouts ensure your Scout Leader signs the form and for all others, your Group Leader or next level of Commissioner is required to sign the form. Then forward it to the NSW Contingent as soon as possible (aj2019membership@patroltent.com).

MEDICAL OBLIGATIONS

If your medical situation or conditions change, from the information you enter into your application, you will need to log back in and update this information immediately to ensure correctness and completeness.

TRANSPORT

- Travel arrangements will be co-ordinated by the Contingent and advised by your Contingent Welfare Leader closer to the event.
- The above Total Fee includes the cost of coach travel of participants, to and from the Jamboree.

NSW CONTINGENT MERCHANDISE FOR PURCHASE

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

- All NSW Leaders, Rovers and other adult supporters are required to hold a current and verified Working With Children Check (WWCC) to attend the 2019 Jamboree. This needs to be recorded in the NSW Membership system (ScoutLink)

INDEPENDENT TRAVEL

- Independent travel by Jamboree Troop members is not permitted.
- Line Leaders must travel with their respective Jamboree Troop.
- Independent Travel for non-Troop based Adult members will be considered.
- Decisions on Independent Travel requests will not be made until after Troop Allocations (expected to be in July 2018).
- Members who submit an Independent Travel request through the on-line application system by 15 August 2018 and receive approval, will have the Final Payment of their Total Fee reduced by \$140 for travel each way, as applicable.
